

## **Parish Investment Update**

In November, Moulton Parish Council received approximately £6,000 in Community Infrastructure Levy, due to a new planning application from Bovis Homes on their Honeyvale Gardens estate. There are strict rules about how the parish council can spend these monies, and we sought project suggestions from the community.

There are eight ideas that have been brought forward for consideration.

Install an all-weather footpath between School Lane and Honeyvale Gardens



Fund £1,000 of trees to be planted adjacent to the MUGA







Install dog waste bins in the village

Install additional and updated CCTV on Moulton park



Purchase and install an armistice bench for VE Day



Widen Jack Lane footpath near Purcell Place

Add lighting to footpath from Holst Gardens to Niddries Lane
